Dear parents,

Greetings shortly before the spring break. I wish you a relaxed holiday week with your children and plenty of shared new experiences.

Before the holidays, we would like to meet with you at parent-teacher meetings, and shortly after the holidays, you are warmly invited to the Open Day. Primarily, we organize this event for potential new learners interested in education at our school. However, it is also an ideal opportunity for parents of our students to observe classes, see their children in the learning process, or get an idea of the format and progress of teaching in specific subjects. On March 20th, for the first three hours, we will have open classrooms, and you will have the opportunity to tour the school, visit different classrooms - including specialized ones, or spend time in your children's classrooms as a silent observer. In March, we also have two holidays that we traditionally celebrate at school.
